Are You Leaving for the Summer?

As many of you are preparing to leave “paradise” for the summer, here’s some tips to remember.

- Consider hiring a home watch company and contract with a service to install shutters in case of a hurricane
- Remove valuables from your home
- Make sure your smoke detectors are working and replace all batteries
- Give close friends and neighbors your travel schedule and contact information in case of an emergency
- Have your air conditioner inspected/serviced. Set the temperature between 80-85 degrees
- Put lights on timers throughout your house to turn on/off at different times
- Store outside furniture, plants, grills, hoses, doormats and outdoor decorations in your garage
- If shipping your car, remove toll road passes (SunPass or E-Z pass) so you’re not charged going thru a toll booth
- Unplug small appliances and TVs
- Turn off water valves to sinks, toilets, washing machine and dishwasher.
